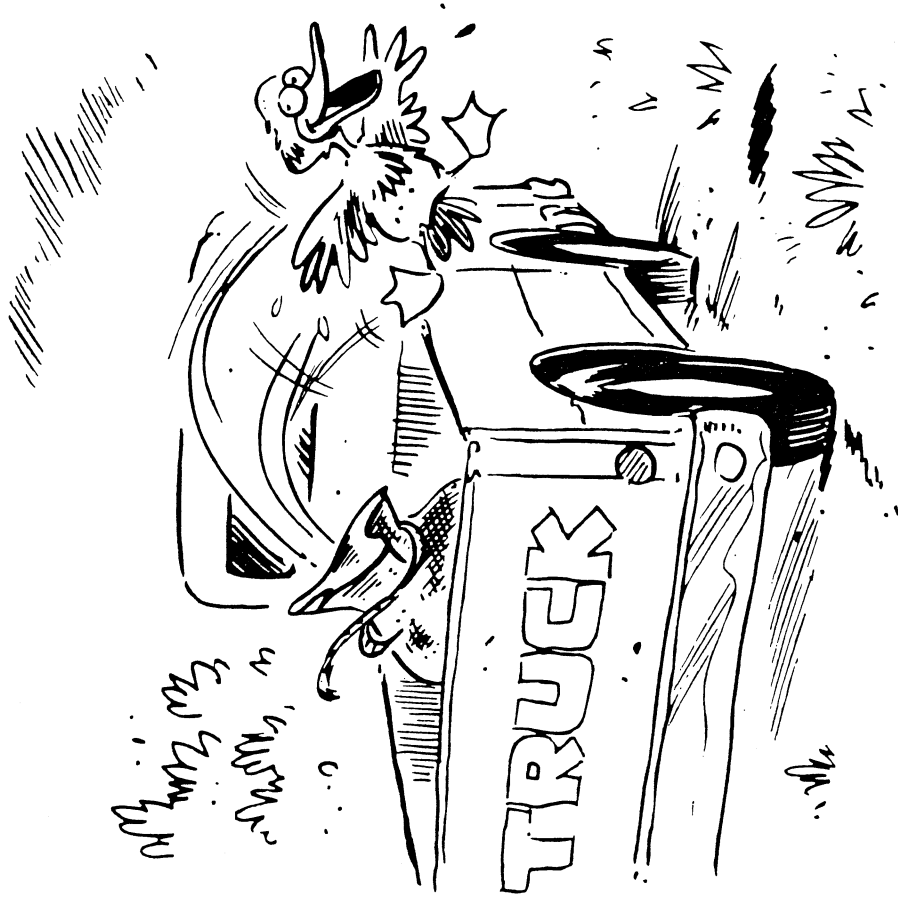

"I am out! I am out!"

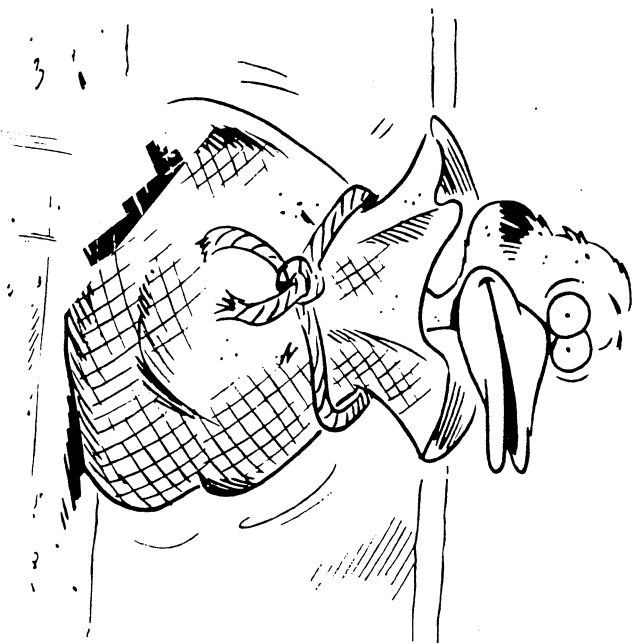


Just then the truck stops
